- Crested ½ zip top
- Sky blue polo top
- Navy tracksuit bottoms(crested version optional) – no leggings or bottoms with logos allowed.
- Crested school shorts are also available for the warmer months


School Uniforms are available from Rathbawn Embroidery, Tullow, Co Carlow

Jewellery / Watches / Glasses:

A simple stud earring is permitted. Dangling / long / looped earrings, bracelets and necklaces are prohibited for health and safety reasons. Make up is not permitted in school. Regular watches (nothing with a capacity to record) are permitted. Children with glasses should bring their storage case to school so they can be stored safely and securely.

The Board of Management cannot be held responsible for loss or damage, howsoever caused to any of the above-mentioned personal property.

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Hair:

Boys and Girls are asked to keep their hair neat and tidy. Long hair must be tied back in the interests of hygiene. Hair dye is not permitted.

Desired outcomes of Uniform Policy:


- Sense of belonging created
